Favorite Recipe

GINGER COOKIES

3/4 cup shortening	2 t. baking soda
1/4 cup molasses (lite)	1/2 t. salt
1 egg	1/2 t. ginger
1 cup sugar	1/2 t. cloves
2 cups flour	1 T. cinnamon

Mix shortening, molasses, egg and sugar together.

Mix in remaining ingredients.

Roll into balls, then roll balls in sugar.

Bake 350 degrees 8-10 min.
