Blueberry Salad

2 pkgs. (3 oz.) Blackberry jello
1 Small can undrained crushed pineapple
1 Can blueberry pie filling
1 ¾ Cup boiling water

Topping:

1 8 oz. cream cheese
½ C. sugar
1 C. sour cream
1/2 tsp. vanilla

Dissolve jello in boiling water; add pineapple & blueberry pie filling. Let set till firm (not solid). Cream together cream cheese & sugar. Add sour cream & vanilla; mix well. Spread over jello. Use a 8 1/2"x11" pan.
