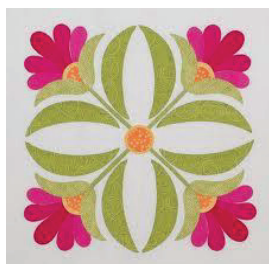

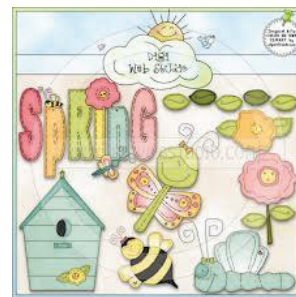

## March Luncheon ~ Chinese

Fried Rice

2 eggs, slightly beaten  
4 slices bacon, cut into ¼ inch pieces  
1/8 c. bacon drippings  
3 tbsp. chopped onions  
3 c. cooked rice  
1/8 c. soy sauc  
1/8 tsp. salt  
1/8 tsp. pepper  
¼ c. whole gree onions, sliced sliced

In medium skillet, scramble eggs, set aside. In large skillet, fry bacon until crisp. Reserve drippings, set aside. Saute onions in drippings. Add rice, stir to combine. Add scrambled egg and bacon. Toss gently with two forks. Serve immediately.
