PICNIC BAKED BEANS (serves 12)

2 (28-oz.) cans baked beans (like Bush's)
1 cup packed brown sugar
1 large onion, chopped
1 cup ketchup
2 tablespoons prepared mustard
2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
4-6 slices bacon

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In 9x13 baking dish, combine all ingredients, except bacon. Top with bacon slices. Bake for 1 hour, or until sauce is thickened and bacon is cooked.
