August 15th

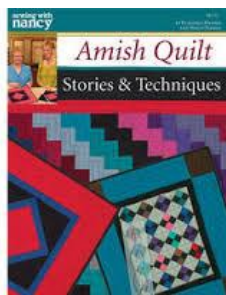
“Car Trash Bags” taught by Maudi, from the St. George Bernina!! What a useful project. Be sure to be there. There is a \$5.00 charge.

#### CARROT CAKE BARS

1 cup sugar  
¾ cup vegetable oil  
2 eggs  
1 cup all-purpose flour  
1 teaspoon cinnamon  
½ teaspoon baking soda  
½ teaspoon salt  
1 cup freshly shredded carrots  
½ cup diced walnuts  
1 can (16 oz.) cream cheese frosting – or use the frosting recipe listed below

Preheat oven to 350°. Grease and flour a 13x9 pan. In large bowl, using electric mixer at medium speed, beat sugar, oil & eggs until light. Stir in flour, cinnamon, baking soda & salt until well combined. Gently stir in carrots and nuts. Pour batter into prepared pan. Bake 25-30 min., or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool completely on wire rack. Spread cream cheese frosting over the top. Cut into 2-inch squares.

#### Cream Cheese Frosting

1 pkg (8 oz.) cream cheese, softened  
¼ cup butter or margarine, softened  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 pkg (16 oz.) powdered sugar (about 4 cups), sifted

In medium bowl, beat cream cheese, butter & vanilla with mixer until well blended. Add sugar gradually, beating after each addition until well blended. ~Kathy

Norah studied Graphics at the Rhode Island School of Design and went to work in publishing advertising. When she moved to central Illinois she saw her first quilts on a visit to the Chicago Art Institute and knew she had to learn how to make them. Her first teacher taught her to do everything by hand but, she soon had two small children and her quilting output amounted to a small stack of blocks. Later on, in California, she discovered that some people made quilts with her old favorite, the sewing machine. She was shown a rotary cutter and she never looked back. Since 1991 she's taught quilt making for the adult education division of her wonderful community college in Santa Barbara. Her students keep her on her toes because they come to class year after year and she wants to provide new ideas and techniques for them. Consequently, she has studied practically every quilt making trend, fad, shortcut and technique. Her personal interests are landscape quilts and challenging piecing. She's learned from other teachers at conferences, workshops and quilt shows and will never stop appreciating the work of other quilters. Now, she's been given the opportunity to write a book!
