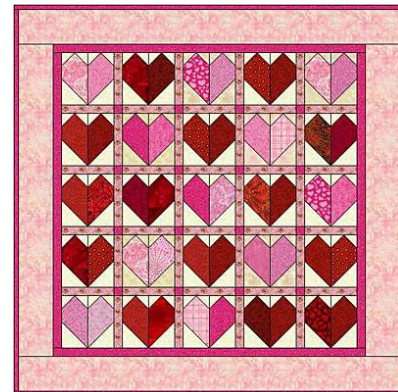
August 7th "Block of the Month"

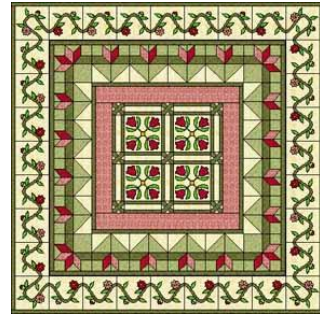
