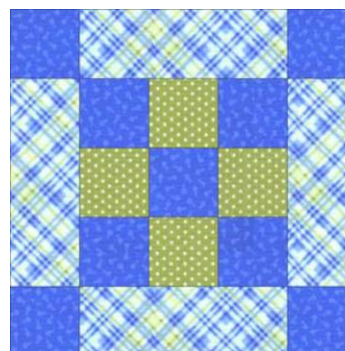

### 2015 Challenge Quilt News

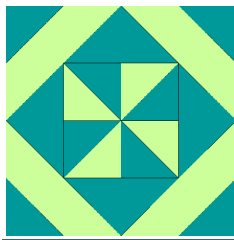

## Trapunto supply list

Embroidery needles, yarn darning needles, white embroidery DMC thread, white yarn (regular knitting yarn), small sharp scissors, 6" embroidery hoop, and regular sewing machine and supplies.

If you have water soluble thread or poly thread that would also be good to bring.

**\*I will have the fabrics and patterns available for a small fee to cover the cost of these supplies, under \$5.**

It will be cheaper than to buy the fabric and will have the patterns already drawn on and ready to sew.

**For June's class it is recommended to bring a artist color wheel and/or a fabric color wheel. A note book to take notes will be helpful. Fabrics from guild members stash would be great to bring, especially if they are not sure if fabrics go together or not.**
