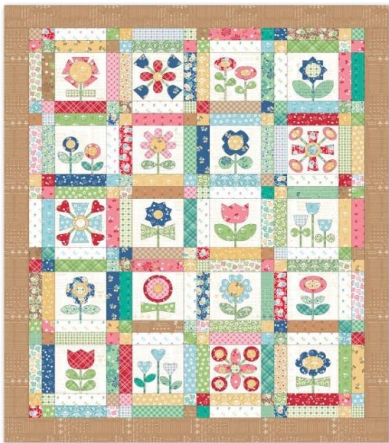

2. Cotton string or rubber bands
3. Liquid dye, 2-3 colors
4. Foam paint brush, optional
5. Plastic dishpan, optional
6. Rubber Gloves, optional
7. Cardboard to pin fabric on, optional
