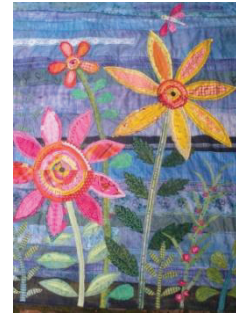

Candied Cereal

Mix together in large container:

- 1 box Golden Grahams cereal
- 1 box Corn Chex cereal
- 1 large pkg. coconut (3 to 4 oz.)
- 1 large pkg. sliced almonds

In heavy sauce pan add:

- 2 C. sugar
- 2 C. light corn syrup

Boil 3 minutes at full rolling boil.
