GRAPE JELLY COCKTAIL MEATBALLS (It's an
oldie, but goodie - and so easy!)

- 2 12-oz. bottles chili sauce (Heinz)
- 1 32-oz. jar grape jelly
- 1 pinch cayenne pepper (optional)
- 3 5-lb. bags frozen cocktail meatballs (Costco)

In a medium saucepan, combine chili sauce,
jelly and cayenne. Heat until warm. Dump
meatballs into crockpot; pour sauce over.
Cook on low 3-4 hours. Makes a large batch.
