# Luncheon

November 14th

November Luncheon: **Chili!**

Our luncheon theme for November is chili. If you would like to bring something to share with your fellow quilters, we need salads, desserts, and pots of chili. Please remember: we are not permitted to use the Senior Center's stove, oven, cooking pots or utensils. So, crock pots are recommended, or casserole dishes that can be set on top of the stove to keep warm. Thanks, everyone.

### EASY CROCK POT CHILI

1 lb. lean ground beef  
3 garlic cloves, crushed  
1 tablespoon ground cumin  
1 tablespoon chili powder (or to taste)  
1/2 teaspoon salt (or to taste)  
1 7-oz. can diced green chiles  
1 medium onion, chopped  
1 30-oz. can pinto beans, undrained  
2 15-oz. cans black beans, rinsed & drained  
1 14-oz. can diced tomatoes, undrained  
1 12-oz. can tomato paste  
In a 4 or 5 qt. slow cooker, mix together beef, garlic, spices, green chiles and onion. Add beans, tomatoes with their liquid, and tomato paste. Mix gently. Cover and cook on low heat setting for 5-6 hours

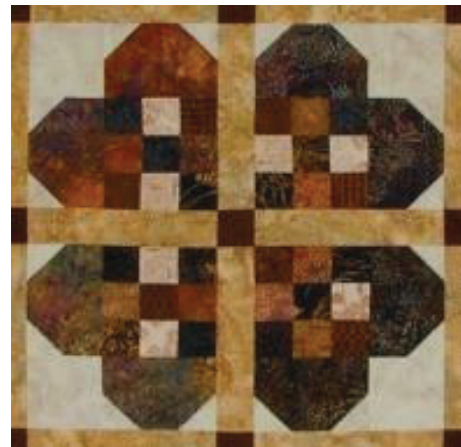
The retreat is four days and three nights featuring twenty-six classes with teachers from Utah and Nevada and our national teacher from California.
