- \* 1st place award will be \$100.
  - 2nd place will be \$75.
  - 3rd place will be \$50.
- \* **CALL SANDI** at 435-867-5535 if you have a quilt to enter in the contest.
- \* Quilt tops will be shown, but *only completed quilts* are eligible for prizes.
- \* Rule was to use 3 initials of your name.
  - 1st initial is your main quilt color
  - 2nd initial is your main quilt block
  - 3rd initial is your main quilting motif
- \* Minimum size is 38"x42". No max size.
- \* Challenge quilts will be displayed at the Heritage Festival Quilt Show.

# Minding our CCQG Business

**PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE BYLAWS** will be presented by the governing board at the regular October 11th general business meeting. Per procedural guidelines specified in the CCQG bylaws, the proposed amendments need to be presented to the general membership a month before they are presented for a vote. A majority of the members present at the November meeting can ratify or reject the proposed changes.

## **PROPOSED CHANGES INCLUDE:**

- Annual dues period will run from March to February.
- Nominations for office will no longer be accepted from the floor.
- More security measures for managing Guild bank account and purchases.
- The Guild Vice President and Retreat Vice-Chair will move into the President and Retreat Chair positions in the following term.
- Various changes in the duties of standing committees.

**PLEASE REVIEW** the "Proposed Amendment" document that is attached in a *\*separate email\**. Feel free to discuss and ask for clarifications before action is taken at the November meeting. Your yea or nay vote is important.
